Donor Bill of Rights

Christian giving is based on voluntary action for the glory of God. It is a tradition of giving and sharing that is primary to the quality of life. To assure that Christian giving merits the respect and trust of the general public, and that donors and prospective donors can have full confidence in East Hill Christian School, we declare that all donors have these rights:

1. To be informed of the East Hill Christian School mission, of the way the organization intends to use donated resources, and of its capacity to use donations effectively for their intended purposes.
2. To be informed of the identity of those serving on the Board of Trustees, and to expect the Board of Trustees to exercise prudent judgment in its stewardship responsibilities.
3. To have access to the most recent financial statements of East Hill Christian School.
4. To be assured their gifts will be used for the purposes for which they were given.
5. To receive appropriate acknowledgement and recognition.
6. To be assured that information about their donations is handled with respect and with confidentiality to the extent provided by law.
7. To expect that all relationships with individuals representing East Hill Christian School to the donor will be professional in nature.
8. To be informed whether those seeking donations are volunteers, employees of East Hill Christian School, or members of the Board of Trustees.
9. To have the opportunity for their names to be deleted from mailing lists that East Hill Christian School may intend to share.
10. To be able to ask questions when making a donation and to receive prompt, truthful, and forthright answers.
