Insurance

Physical Examinations

In order to participate in EHCS Athletics, an annual physical examination is required. **Please note:** This form must be completed and returned before any candidate for a team may participate in any practice.

Athletic Handbook

The **Athletic Handbook** is available online, at our website under the Athletics tab at www.ehcs.org. The handbook contains the rules and regulations for participation in extracurricular activities at EHCS. After reading the handbook, parents and students must sign the **Athletic Handbook Agreement Form**.

Gate and Concession Duty

Parents of student athletes will be asked to help work the **entrance gate** and the **concession stand** at our home athletic events. These events help to support the athletic program and parent participation is an essential element of making this successful!

Athletic Awards Ceremony

An awards ceremony is held at the conclusion of each sport season (fall, winter, and spring). This is a ceremony to recognize and honor those student-athletes who have participated in one of the various teams for that season.
